

Indiana State Women's Rally Flag



Finished flag is 21" height and 28" width.

Made with Red Heart Knitting Worsted Yarn

2 Super skeins (7 oz, 354 yards) blue

1 super skein (7 oz., 354 yards) gold [Note: only about 1/2 of the second skein of blue was needed.]

Size 6 circular needle 29 in

Gauge: 10 st. = 2 in.; 12 rows = 2 in.

The stars on the Indiana State flag are replaced with the female symbol and the torch is morphed into a raised fist.

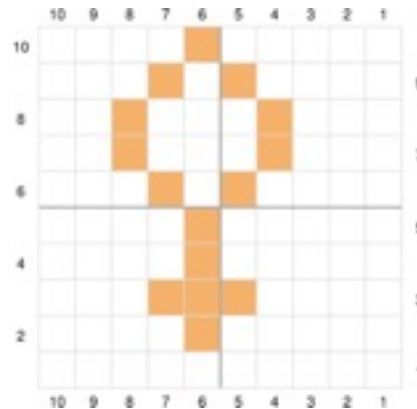
Cast on 140 stitches. Work in seed stitch. Place markers 5 st. from ea. end.

Work in the above pattern while following the color chart.

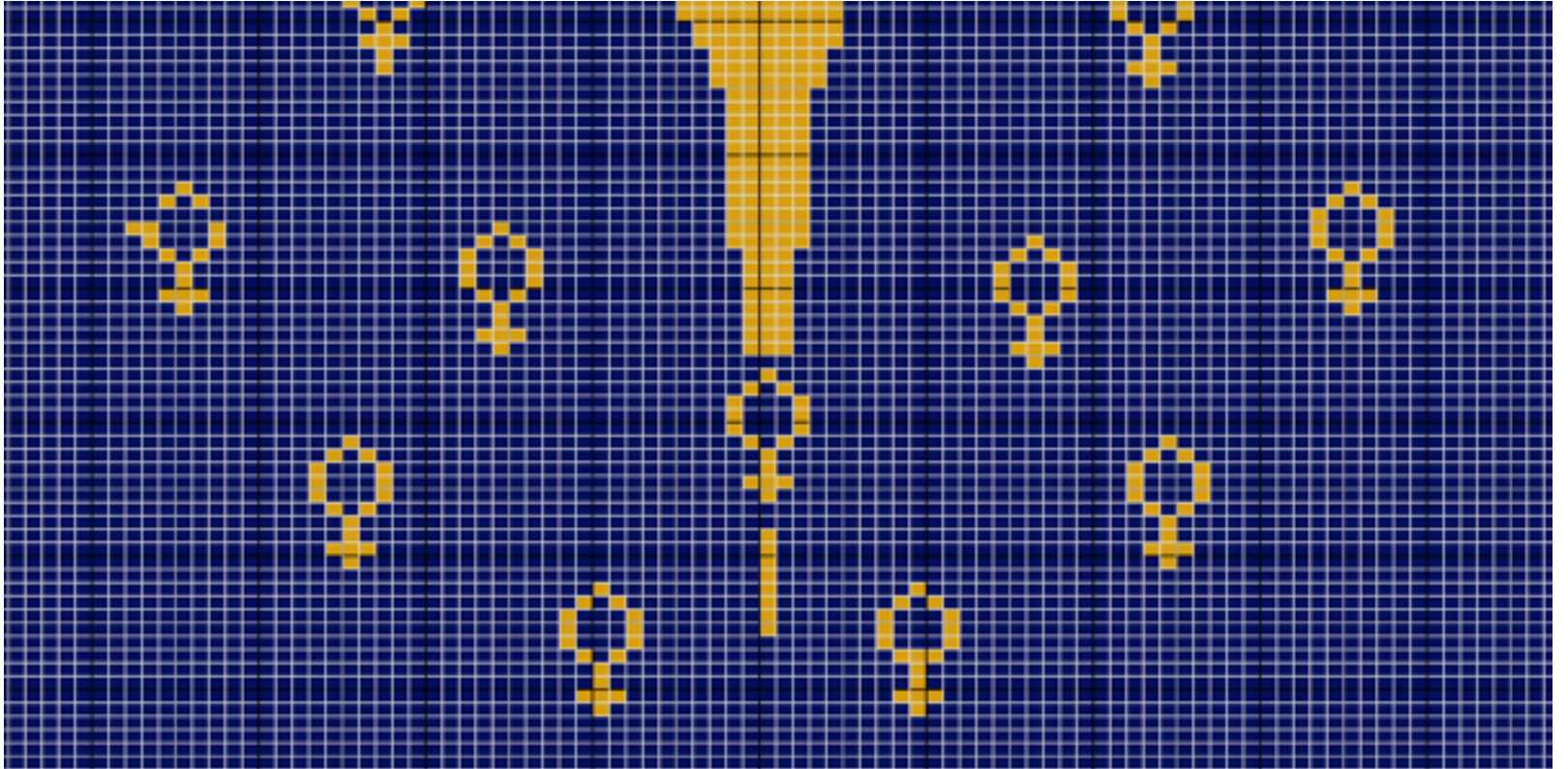
RS: K the P st. and P the K stitches on first and last 5 st. K all others

WS: P the K st. and K the p stitches on first and last 5 st. p all others

Chart showing the feminist symbol stitches:

A close-up is provided of the chart's inner fist and the larger feminist symbol above the fist.



The chart was created on StitchFiddle and is my own work, made by adjusting the Indiana flag's torch into a raised fist and replacing the stars with the symbol for female.
